# Seesaw

This year as a school we will be trialling Seesaw. Seesaw is an online sharing tool that is private only to you and your family. It gives you access to photos, videos and activities that your child is involved in at school. It is very similar to Storypark that many of you will be familiar with from your child's Early Childhood Centre. The purpose of Seesaw is to keep families up to date with what is happening in their child's learning on a regular basis.

During 2018 two classes were using Seesaw and they found it a great way to share what is going on in the classroom with family and the response from parents was extremely positive and everyone found it really easy to set up and use.

The content in Seesaw is not available to anyone who doesn't have a specific code. This means that only your class members can see the posts. It is not like Facebook where you can see everything. It is also not compulsory to join. If you feel it isn't for you, that is perfectly fine.

The content will be in a variety of forms. It could be a whole class post, a group post, an individual post or an activity for the children. Whichever form is used, it will give you a great insight into what is happening in your child's learning each week. You will be able to comment on these posts - this becomes very motivating for the children! Teachers are in total control of these posts and any comments have to be approved before they will be posted.

To get started...each child will receive a specific QR Code. It has instructions for how to download the app or view Seesaw online. Follow these instructions and you will be set up. You can have multiple people using the app. Each of these people will need to use this code and instructions to set up. It is extremely important for privacy reasons that this code is not shared on Social Media. If you have any problems or questions about the set up please don't hesitate to come and ask Mrs C on Monday afternoons straight after assembly.
